

Esophageal Manometry prep

Do not take food or liquid for six (6) hours before the procedure. We want to study the esophagus in its natural state. In other words, there should not be any medicine in the body that can effect the function of the esophagus.

Discontinue these medications 72 hours before the procedure:

Protonix (pantoprazole sodium) **Prilosec** (Omeprazole) **Aciphex**
(rabeprazole sodium)

Prevacid (lansoprazole) **Nexium** (esomeprazole magnesium)

Discontinue these medications 24 hours before the procedure:

Tagamet (cimetidine) **Reglan** (metachlopramide)

Axid

Pepcid (famotidine) **Zantac** (ranitidine)

There are several drugs for the heart that can also effect the esophagus.

They include:

Nafepipine

Procardia

Nitroglycerin

If you are taking medicines for your heart, please ask if these medicines should be discontinued for the procedure.
